GBP 1,000 of the amount paid, in respect of Property Damage caused by or arising out of the use of any mechanically propelled vehicle, for damages and claimants costs and expenses in respect of one occurrence or all occurrences of a series consequent on or attributable to one source or original cause.

(c) Motor Vehicle Bodily Injury

NIL of the amount paid, in respect of Bodily Injury caused by or arising out of the use of any mechanically propelled vehicle, for damages and claimants costs and expenses in respect of one occurrence or all occurrences of a series consequent on or attributable to one source or original cause.

Item 8. Number of Motor Vehicles
