



New Inventory





We've embarked on an ambitious project within our Car Spares department, aimed at revolutionizing our inventory management. To achieve this, we're implementing an advanced inventory system, powered by Eladene Systems. Each car part will be assigned a unique bar code. This end-to-end traceability will span the entire life cycle of each part, from its arrival in the yard to its delivery to our valued customers. The benefits are far-reaching.

With a new inventory system comes a new storage unit in the yard and have installed a mezzanine level and new racking throughout. We have already begun adding our stock such as front ends and bumpers and barcoding each section of storage to specific zones. This innovative approach allows our reception team to swiftly check the system and see if we have the parts our customer are looking for.
